 - If you don't sign up online, you can sign up at the door.
 - Our capacity is 100 (not including volunteers) which we have not exceeded on any Sunday, yet. *If family or households sit together*, it helps use the space well.
- **Experience of a Sunday service**
 - Please practice a physical distance of 6-feet when indoors.
 - The congregation is requested to wear masks when participating in the service.
 - If you can bring one that is appreciated but we have some here, including ones for children.
 - Those on the platform don't wear masks when ministering.

 - Hand sanitizer is available for your convenience.
 - Enter through multipurpose doors (*Feel free to come as early as 15 minutes before service time.*)
 - Ushers help you find seating which are staggered with every other row roped off and three empty seats between households/families.
 - No offering plates are passed but you can use the offering boxes or give online at www.rfcov.org/give.
 - Jr. Church and Nursery are not available at this time.
 - At the end of service, please exit through south door of the Worship Center and we hope you can take some time to fellowship together outside.
