Amos Chapter 7

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Use these questions for further study individually or in a small group

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Read Amos Chapter 8:1-9:10

We see two more visions of the coming judgment to Israel. What is your response to God's commitment to carry it out His judgment?

In the third vision [Ch. 8:4-6] we see the crimes of the people. How do you see the church guilty of these same sins today? Or the other sins that Amos lays before God's people?

How do you respond to the sin in your life being called out?

Amos shows us that no matter where we go we cannot hide from God and His judgment. Whether we go up to the heavens or to the depths, whether the tallest of mountains or the depths of the seas, or any of the lands of the earth, we are able to be found. How do you respond knowing that you cannot hide from God nor His judgment?

Amos also challenges Israel that they are not exempt from God's judgment because they are better than the surrounding nations or because God brought them up in the exodus from Egypt. They are actually found more guilty than the other nations because they agreed to be in covenant with God. They were called to be holy and set a part as God's own people. They failed in this and refused to listen when God was calling them back to Himself. In what ways do we in the church see ourselves as being exempt from God's judgment? In what ways do we see God's promise of judgment on us?

- 2. What challenged you in what you believe and how you live?
- 3. What needs to change in your life if we are to live out these Words of God?
- 4. What questions do you still have?

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
