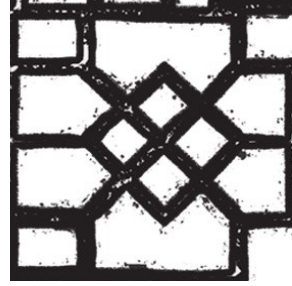

Go Deeper . . .

Use these questions for further study individually or in a small group

. . . he ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit;

This section of the Creed focuses on the present and future activity of Jesus.

Read Colossians 2:9 & Hebrews 7:17-8:6

- What is significant about the reality that the ascended Jesus is still embodied (fully human)?
- What is the current work/ministry of Jesus?
- How is the priesthood of Jesus different from what came before?

Read Colossians 3:1-17

- How does this passage speak to the *ascension, session, and second coming*? Where do you see each of these realities named?
- What does it mean to be “raised with Christ”?
- What are the practical implications of the fact that Christians’ lives are now “hidden in Christ with God”?
- How can you take steps to live out these commands and realities?
- What other questions do you have about this passage?

Read 1 Corinthians 12:1-31

- What does this passage teach us about the Holy Spirit?
- What does this passage teach about the different kinds of gifts the Holy Spirit gives?
- What does this passage teach us about the purpose of the gifts?
- What does this passage teach us about how people who have received different gifts should interact with one another?
- What does it mean to “eagerly desire the greater gifts?”
- Why is it important to remember that the gifts come from and belong to the Spirit and not to us?

Pray and ask the Lord if there is a gift he wants to give you, or if there is a way you are being called to use one of his gifts for the edification of his Church.

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
