Is the Kingdom a present reality, a future reality, both? Explain.

What does Jesus mean when he says to become like children?

What role does humility play here?

Why is this a requirement for entering the Kingdom?

What does it mean to welcome a child? How does this connect to Jesus?

What does it mean to "scandalize" a child, or cause them to sin/fall away?

What are specific examples of this?

Why is it so serious?

Why does Jesus use such radical language about addressing sin/falling away?

What does this look like in practice?

What keeps us from taking radical actions in pursuit of holiness?
